WEEK OF JUNE 23: Pray for God's leadership for identification and formation of a new vision. Though we laid aside the dreams of Vision 2020 for a season, we are eager to return to dreaming of a future story. Each day this week, ask God to guide us.

WEEK OF JUNE 30: Ask God for wisdom, creativity, listening hearts, and openness to the voice of calling throughout this process of identifying our vision.

WEEK OF JULY 7: Pray that as we consider our future we will be good stewards of our financial resources, that we will give extravagantly, and that we move forward in wisdom.

WEEK OF JULY 14: Request God's guidance for our staff as they seek to lead us into uncharted waters. Ask that God would lead them to be faithful to the story of this people and place while moving forward in faith.

WEEK OF JULY 21: Pray for the graceful sharing of ideas, in unity and in diversity, and that we would operate out of great love for each other and Christ. As we have prayed together this week, ask God to unite us in mission.

WEEK OF JULY 28: Intercede for the Sugar Land community. Pray that we will discover our part in God's plans for its redemption. Each day, ask that we will see the needs around us and have a heart to meet them.

WEEK OF AUGUST 4: Pray for generosity and a sense of purpose for everyone who participates in what God is doing in our midst.

WEEK OF AUGUST 11: Pray for the members and the work of our leadership committee. Ask specifically that they would be empowered by the spirit and trusted by the church.

WEEK OF AUGUST 18: Pray for those who will walk these halls seeking hope, healing, and wholeness. Ask God to equip us to be like salt and like light in our community.
